Cadets in training phases 3 and 4 will be working on classes to acquire their Pleasure Craft Operators Permit's and their VHF Restricted Radio License's over the months of January and February. We asked that these cadets make an effort to attend as may Thursday Nights as possible, so as not to miss important information during these classes.

Regular Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C5 – STU - Blue Shirts, Black Pants, Boots, Ball Cap) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
CO's Parade Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1900 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C3 - Service Dress (With Black Tunics!) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. The CO's Parade or Commanding Officers Parade involves uniform inspections and special presentations in addition to regular training classes. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
Communications	Cadets who have signed up with SLt Batten in advance will have the opportunity to participate in various forms of communications training. This is optional training and equipment restrictions mean that cadets must apply in advance with SLt Batten. <i>Please do not come Friday expecting to sign up!</i> Dress C5 STU unless otherwise informed.
Beginning Band Practice	This is an optional activity (We strongly encourage all cadets to try it out!). No previous experience is needed. Cadets will be provided with instruments, music and all the instruction (from professional music instructors!) they will require to succeed! Beginning Band practice takes place Friday Evening from 1900 hrs till 2100 hrs. Practice takes place at the Ship -16 South Front St. Belleville. Please see SLt Colwill if you have any questions.
Sr. Band Practice	This is an optional activity. Sr. Band is for those cadets who have completed the Beginning Band program. Practice takes place Saturday mornings from 1000 hrs till 1200 hrs. Year 1 & 2 Cadets Regional Activity	Cadets currently in their first or second training year will have the opportunity to participate in a regional organized activity day on Sunday the 14 th . Cadets who cannot attend must let SLt Taylor know ASAP so he does not register them. More information on this event will be distributed as soon as it is received at the unit.
Swimming	This is an optional activity offered to all cadets. Swimming will take place at the Belleville Wellness Centre. Cadets are asked to show up at 1915 hrs (715pm) to give them time to change before the pool opens at 1930 hrs. The swim will end at 2100 hrs (9pm) and parents are asked to be ready to pick up their cadets once they have changed to not hold up facility staff. There is no cost to the cadets for this event. Cadets will be required to wear appropriate civilian clothes to and from the pool and bring an appropriate swimsuit / swim wear for in the pool. List event is limited to 20 cadets. There will be a sign up list posted. Any cadets who do not get the opportunity this month will be given priority for next months swimming day.
(February) Seamanship Weekend	On the weekend of February 3 rd – 4 th , cadets are strongly encouraged to participate in a multi-unit activity being held at our building. The weekend will comprise of seamanship skills training, naval traditions, divisional competitions and fun activities. This is an overnight (on-board) activity, however those cadets wishing to be picked up Saturday evening and brought back Sunday morning are welcome to do so. Meals will be provided for this activity.
