Seamanship Weekend	This is a mandatory activity for all cadets. Cadets will be staying overnight at the building. Sr Cadets will be coming on Friday February 3rd and staying Friday night. All remaining cadets will be coming to the building at 0800 hrs (8am) on Saturday morning and staying until 1600 hrs (4pm) on Sunday. Dress for this weekend is C5 (STU), cadets will also need to bring appropriate civilian clothes and sleepwear. All food for this event is provided. (Please see Kit List and Information on the Website)
Regular Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C5 - STU (Sea Training Uniform – Blue Shirts, Black Pants, Ball Cap) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs.
CO's Parade Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C# - Service Dress for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. The CO's Parade or Commanding Officers Parade involves uniform inspections and special presentations in addition to regular training classes.
Band Practice	This is an optional activity (We strongly encourage all cadets to try it out!). No previous experience is needed. Cadets will be provided with instruments, music and all the instruction (from professional music instructors!) they will require to succeed! Band practice takes place Saturday mornings from 1000 hrs till 1200 hrs. Please see SLt Colwill if you have any questions.
Communications	Cadets who have signed up with SLt Batten in advance will have the opportunity to participate in various forms of communications training. This is optional training and equipment restrictions mean that cadets must apply in advance with SLt Batten. <i>Please do not come Friday expecting to sign up!</i> Dress C5 STU unless otherwise informed.
Communication Course	This is an optional course offered at the program allowing cadets to obtain their federal amateur radio license. Cadets interested in this course will have to sign up with SLt Batten. Restrictions on this course such as available slots, course cycle and cadets current training level may apply.
Open Range (Marksmanship)	This is an optional activity open to all cadets! Marksmanship taught with Air Rifles is a core element of the Sea Cadet Program. Open Range is an opportunity for cadets to come and learn or practice their skills. Cadets are able to work towards earning Marksmanship levels during this time. Open Range takes place on Saturdays from 1330 – 1600 hrs (1:30pm – 4pm). Dress is appropriate civilian clothing (somewhat baggy and comfortable is easier to shoot in!)
Swimming	This is an optional activity. Activity is limited to 25 cadets. Priority will be given to those cadets who signed up last month but were unable to be selected to swim. A sign-up list will be posted in the main hallways at the cadet building before the event. Swimming will take place at the Belleville Wellness Centre. Cadets are asked to show up at 1915 hrs (7:15pm) to give them time to change before the pool opens at 1930 hrs. The swim will end at 2100 hrs (9pm) and parents are asked to be ready to pick up their cadets once they have changed in order to not hold up facility staff. There is no cost to the cadets for this event. Cadets will be required to wear appropriate civilian clothes to and from the pool and bring an appropriate swimsuit / swim wear for in the pool.
