Regular Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C5 – STU - Blue Shirts, Black Pants, Boots, Ball Cap) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
CO's Parade Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1900 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C3 - Service Dress (With Black Tunics!) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. The CO's Parade or Commanding Officers Parade involves uniform inspections and special presentations in addition to regular training classes. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
Communications	Cadets who have signed up with SLt Batten in advance will have the opportunity to participate in various forms of communications training. This is optional training and equipment restrictions mean that cadets must apply in advance with SLt Batten. <i>Please do not come Friday expecting to sign up!</i> Dress C5 STU unless otherwise informed.

Parents / Guardians are encouraged to stay and observe the ceremony. The Dress for this event is C1/C3 Ceremonial Dress. Please remember to bring parkas and gloves.
Santa Claus Parade	This is an optional activity. Cadets will have the opportunity to participate in the Belleville Santa Claus Parade. Cadets are asked to arrive at the Belleville Curling Rink on Bridge Street for 1600 hrs. The parade will start at 1630 hrs. The parade will finish at the Bayview Mall at approximately 1930 hrs. Parents / Guardians are asked to be at the finish location to pick up their cadets. <u>This activity is open to both Band Members and Non-Band Members.</u> The Dress for this event is C3 Ceremonial Dress.
