Regular Training Nights

Parade ends at 2100 hrs. The Annual Ceremonial Review involves uniform inspections and special presentations in addition to Year End Awards and Promotions. . Parents / Guardians, Friends and Family are encouraged to stay and observe the event. Parade takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.

Communications
