Regular Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C3A – Summer Service Dress –White Shirts, Black Pants, Parade Boots, White Top and no Tie) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
CO's Parade Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1900 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C3 - Service Dress (With Black Tunics!) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. The CO's Parade or Commanding Officers Parade involves uniform inspections and special presentations in addition to regular training classes. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
Band Practice	This is an optional activity (We strongly encourage all cadets to try it out!). No previous experience is needed. Cadets will be provided with instruments, music and all the instruction (from professional music instructors!) they will require to succeed! Band practice takes place Saturday mornings from 1000 hrs till 1200 hrs. Practice takes place at the Ship -16 South Front St. Belleville. Please see SLt Colwill if you have any questions.
Communications	Cadets who have signed up with SLt Batten in advance will have the opportunity to participate in various forms of communications training. This is optional training and equipment restrictions mean that cadets must apply in advance with SLt Batten. <i>Please do not come Friday expecting to sign up!</i> Dress C5 STU unless otherwise informed.
Mess Dinner	A long naval tradition attending Mess Dinners. Cadets will have the opportunity to participate in one at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville, on the evening of the 6 th . <u>There is no cost to this event.</u> Cadets are asked to arrive at 1800 hrs. Pick up is at 2100 hrs. Dress is C2 (Mess Dress) or C3 (Service Dress). Cadets are encouraged to bring a dessert to share for the dinner. If you have any food restrictions please inform SLt Colwill ASAP. Please see SLt Bresett if you have any questions.
Battle of the Atlantic Ceremony	Battle of the Atlantic is a naval remembrance ceremony held every year on the first Sunday in May. It commemorates the WW2 naval battle for supremacy of the Atlantic Ocean, in which Canadian, British and American naval and civilian ships fought to maintain an open supply line to allied forces in Europe. Cadets will be participating in a ceremony held at the Belleville Cenotaph. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C3 - Service Dress (With Black Tunics!) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Cadets need to arrive at the Cenotaph at 1330 hrs. Ceremony should conclude by 1500 hrs.
Amazing Race Quinte	Amazing Race Quinte is an exciting afternoon of activities where cadets will be able to compete and use the skills they have learn over the year to participate in a fun filled race course. Lunch will be provided. Dress for this event is appropriate civilian clothing. The race will take place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville. Please see SLt Bresett if you have any questions.
End of Year BBQ & Parents Night	There will be a BBQ at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville, for the cadets and parents / guardians to celebrate the conclusion of the formal part of the training year. The BBQ will start at 1800 hrs. Cadets are asked to arrive in uniform as the CO's Parade and Regular Training Night will start at 1900 hrs. There will be a brief information session for those parents wishing to attend.
