**Regular Training Nights**

This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C5 – STU - Blue Shirts, Black Pants, Boots, Ball Cap) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.

**Band Practice**

This is an optional activity. Band is for those cadets who have an interest in learning to play an instrument. Practice takes place Saturday mornings from 1000 hrs till 1200 hrs. Practice takes place at the Ship -16 South Front St. Belleville. Please see SLt Colwill if you have any questions.

**Mess Dinner**

This is an optional activity. Cadets will have the opportunity to participate in a festive Naval Mess Dinner. This is a ceremonial dinner and will involve many naval customs and traditions. The Dress for this event is C2 Mess Dress for cadets in year 2+ or black pants / white shirt for first year cadet who have not been issued a ceremonial uniform yet. Cadets are asked to show up for Cocktails (Non-Alcoholic) at 1800 hrs (6pm). Dinner will conclude at 2130 hrs (9:30pm). There is no cost for this activity, food is provided. We ask that, if able, cadets bring something for dessert to share with their shipmates.
