Annual Ceremonial Review Practice	Cadets will be participating in practicing for the upcoming Annual Ceremonial Review (Year End Graduation Parade). Practice starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C3 Service Dress (Black Jacket, White Shirt). Practice ends at 2130 hrs. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
Band Practice	This is an optional activity. Band is for those cadets who have an interest in learning to play an instrument. Practice takes place Saturday mornings from 1000 hrs till 1200 hrs. Mess Dinner	This is an optional activity. Cadets will have the opportunity to participate in a Naval Mess Dinner. This is a ceremonial dinner and will involve many naval customs and traditions. Gash (Trash) Bash	Cadets will be conducting a Gash Bash on Thursday the 8th of May from 1800 hrs to 2030 hrs (6pm – 8:30pm) along the Waterfront Trail in Belleville Ontario. Cadets are asked to meet at the Myers Pier Parking Lot off Harbour Dr for 1745 hrs (5:45pm). Dress for this activity is C5 – Sea Training Uniform. Cadets are asked to bring a water bottle with them and eat before arriving as there will not be the normal snack options that are provided on most training nights. The Gash Bash will start at the Pier and move eastward along the trail towards the turtle pond before returning to the Myers Pier parking lot for 2015 hrs (8:15pm).
