Regular Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C5 – STU - Blue Shirts, Black Pants, Boots, Ball Cap) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
CO's Parade Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1900 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C3 - Service Dress (With Black Tunics!) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. The CO's Parade or Commanding Officers Parade involves uniform inspections and special presentations in addition to regular training classes. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
Communications	Cadets who have signed up with SLt Batten in advance will have the opportunity to participate in various forms of communications training. This is optional training and equipment restrictions mean that cadets must apply in advance with SLt Batten. <i>Please do not come Friday expecting to sign up!</i> Dress C5 STU unless otherwise informed.
Band Practice	This is an optional activity (We strongly encourage all cadets to try it out!). No previous experience is needed. Cadets will be provided with instruments, music and all the instruction (from professional music instructors!) they will require to succeed! Band practice takes place Saturday mornings from 1000 hrs till 1200 hrs. Practice takes place at the Ship -16 South Front St. Belleville. Please see SLt Colwill if you have any questions.
Food Bank Donation Drive	Cadets will have the opportunity to volunteer with the local Food Bank donation drive. Cadets are to meet at Market Square (behind Belleville City Hall) at 1045 hrs (1045am). Pick up will be at the Gleaners Food Bank building at 1700 hrs (5pm). Dress for this event is C5 STU or appropriate civilian clothes in not yet issued a uniform. Cadets will be provided lunch during this event.

Poppy Distribution	Cadets will have the opportunity to assist the Royal Canadian Legion with their yearly Poppy Drive by handing out Poppies around Belleville. Cadets are asked to arrive at the cadet building by 1200 hrs (noon). They will be partnered and sent to various locations around Belleville. Dress will be C5 STU (Blue Shirt Uniform). Cadets are asked to eat lunch before arriving. Parent volunteers will be need for this event. Please contact Lt(N) Wisniewski if you are able to help.
Fitness Day	There will be a sports and fitness day held at the cadet building (ship) from 0900 – 1600 hrs (9am – 4pm). Cadets are asked to arrive in appropriate civilian clothing. The activity will take place both inside and outside. Lunch will be provided. Cadets are required to bring a water bottle. Some cadets will also be asked to help with derigging the boats in preparation for winter storage.
