Regular Training Nights	This is the mandatory training nights. Parade starts at 1830 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C3A – Summer Service Dress –White Shirts, Black Pants, Parade Boots, White Top and no Tie) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2130 hrs. Training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
Annual Ceremonial Review & Awards	This is the mandatory training night. Parade starts at 1800 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C3 - Service Dress (With Black Tunics!) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2100 hrs. The Annual Ceremonial Review involves cadet inspection and special presentations. This end of the year review marks the end of normal weekly training for year. Unit awards and promotions will take place after the review. Parade takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville.
Band Practice	This is an optional activity (We strongly encourage all cadets to try it out!). No previous experience is needed. Cadets will be provided with instruments, music and all the instruction (from professional music instructors!) they will require to succeed! Band practice takes place Saturday mornings from 1000 hrs till 1200 hrs. Practice takes place at the Ship -16 South Front St. Belleville. Please see SLt Colwill if you have any questions.
Communications	Cadets who have signed up with SLt Batten in advance will have the opportunity to participate in various forms of communications training. This is optional training and equipment restrictions mean that cadets must apply in advance with SLt Batten. <i>Please do not come Friday expecting to sign up!</i> Dress C5 STU unless otherwise informed.
On-Water Sailing / Boating Weekend	We will be hosting an OVERNIGHT training weekend on the 10 th -11 th of June at The Ship (16 South Front St.) This weekend will focus on providing opportunities for our cadets to learn and work on their sailing and motor boating skills. While it is the intention for the cadets to be on the water all weekend, activities are subject to weather conditions. In the event of poor weather, substitute training will be provided indoors. The event starts at 0800 hrs on Saturday and concludes at 1600 hrs on Sunday. Lunches, supper and breakfast will be provided for the cadets. On-Water Training	After the Annual Ceremonial Review and the conclusion of regular training for the 2022/2023 training year, we will switch to optional On-Water training for the remained of the month of June.
