<b>Change of Command</b>	<p>This is the mandatory parade nights. Parade starts at 1800 hrs. Cadets need to be present 15 minutes early to be ready for the start of parade. Dress is C1 – Ceremonial Dress for those cadets with Medals awarded to them or C3 - Service Dress (With Black Tunics!) for those with a uniform (unless otherwise stated) or business casual for those cadets who are yet to be issued a uniform. Parade ends at 2100 hrs. Change of Command is the units opportunity to say thank you to our outgoing Commanding Officer and to welcome our new Commanding Officer. The parade involves uniform inspections and cadet march pasts. Parade takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville. Parents / Guardians, Friends and Family are encouraged to stay and observe the event.</p>
<b>On-Water Training</b>	<p>This training will vary between, Sail, Powerboat and Whaler, and is offered to all cadets. Dress for this is appropriate outdoor clothes / sailing clothing. Cadets are asked to bring an extra dry set of clothes. This training takes place at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville. In the event of unfavorable weather conditions, interior training will still take place at the unit. Timing are the regular 1830-2130 hrs.</p>
<b>Cadet Nautical Centre – Kingston</b>	<p>Some cadets will have the opportunity to attend the Cadet Training Centre in Kingston for a weekend of Sail Training. This is a space limited event. Cadets are asked to sign-up on the list in the main entranceway. Cadets who are selected will be notified in advance. More opportunities will be available for those cadets not selected in the fall. Lunch is provided both days. Dress is appropriate sailing clothing. Please bring an extra set of dry clothes as cadets will most likely get wet. Cadets are to be at the Ship – 16 South Front St. Belleville, for 0700 hrs to get on a bus to Kingston. The bus will not wait for late cadets. The bus is scheduled to arrive back at the Ship around 1700-1730 hrs. Please see Lt(N) Wisniewski if you have any questions.</p>
<b>On-Water Sailing</b>	<p>The unit will be hosting a sail training day on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June at The Ship (16 South Front St.) This day will focus on providing opportunities for cadets to learn and work on their sailing and motor boating skills. While it is the intention for the cadets to be on the water all day, activities are subject to weather conditions. In the event of poor weather, substitute training will be provided indoors. The event starts at 0800 hrs and concludes at 1700 hrs. Lunche will be provided for the cadets. Dress for this event is appropriate sailing / boating clothes.
